18	Petitioner, Manuel Alvarez, is a federal prisoner proceeding with a petition for writ of	
19	habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241. On December 13, 2017, the copy of an order mailed	
20	to Petitioner was returned to the Clerk marked "undeliverable, RTS-Refused."	
21	Local Rule 183 provides:	
22	A party appearing <i>in propria persona</i> shall keep the Court and opposing parties advised as to his or her current address. If mail directed to a plaintiff <i>in propria persona</i> by the Clerk is returned by the U.S. Postal Service, and if such Plaintiff fails to notify the Court and opposing parties within sixty-three (63) days

25	thereafter of a current address, the Court may dismiss the action without prejudice for failure to prosecute.	
26	Although more than sixty-three (63) days have elapsed from the date the order mailed to

28	Petitioner was returned, Petitioner has failed to advise the Court of his current address or contact  1

1	the Court in any other way. The Court has discretion to impose any and all sanctions authorized		
2	by statute or rule or within the inherent power of the Court, including dismissing the motion,		
3	based on a petitioner's failure to comply with a court rule. F.R.Civ.P. 11; Local R. 110.		
4	Conclusion and Recommendation		
5			
6	Based on the foregoing, the undersigned RECOMMENDS that as a result of Petitioner's		
7	failure to prosecute the case, the Court dismiss the petition for writ of habeas corpus in the above		
8	captioned action without prejudice.		
9	These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District		
10	Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C § 636(b)(1). Within thirty		
11	(30) days after being served with these Findings and Recommendations, Petitioner may file		
12 13	written objections with the Court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate		
14	Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Petitioner is advised that failure to file objections		
15	within the specified time may constitute waiver of the right to appeal the District Court's order.		
16	Wilkerson v. Wheeler, 772 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014) (citing Baxter v. Sullivan, 923 F.2d		
17	1391, 1394 (9th Cir. 1991)).		
18	The Court Clerk is hereby directed to assign a district judge to this action.
