ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING 13 DISMISSAL OF CERTAIN CLAIMS AND v. **DEFENDANTS** 14 COUNTY OF TULARE, et al., (ECF No. 19) 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff Daniel Dean Alvarado, Jr. ("Plaintiff") is a former pretrial detainee proceeding 18 pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. 19 On April 22, 2019, the assigned Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's first amended 20 complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, and found that it stated a cognizable claim for excessive 21 force in violation of the Fourteenth Amendment against Defendant Rales, but failed to state any 22 other cognizable claims against any other defendants. Accordingly, the Magistrate Judge issued findings and recommendations that this action proceed on Plaintiff's first amended complaint 23 24 against Defendant Rales for excessive force in violation of the Fourteenth Amendment and all other claims and defendants be dismissed from this action for failure to state a claim. (ECF No. 25 26 19.) The findings and recommendations were served on Plaintiff and contained notice that any 27 objections were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after service. (Id. at 7.) No objections have 28 been filed, and the deadline in which to do so has expired.

1	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a
2	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the
3	findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.
4	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
5	1. The findings and recommendations issued on April 22, 2019, (ECF No. 19), are
6	adopted in full;
7	2. This action shall proceed on Plaintiff's first amended complaint, filed November 16,
8	2018, (ECF No. 18), against Defendant Rales for excessive force in violation of the
9	Fourteenth Amendment;
10	3. All other claims and defendants are dismissed based on Plaintiff's failure to state
11	claims upon which relief may be granted; and
12	4. This action is referred back to the assigned Magistrate Judge for further proceedings
13	consistent with this order.
14	IT IS SO ORDERED.
