On September 28, 2023, the parties filed a joint stipulation for dismissal without prejudice of Defendant County of Tulare as the parties have stipulated that “Plaintiff’s claims against the County of Tulare properly proceed against the Tulare County Sheriff’s Department.” (ECF No. 164, p. 2). In light of the parties’ stipulation, Plaintiff’s claims against Defendant County of Tulare have been terminated, Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), and have been dismissed without prejudice.
