Plaintiff Sam Drake is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

On March 9, 2018, Plaintiff filed a notice indicating that he never received a full copy of the Court's February 23, 2018 screening order. Instead, Plaintiff contends that on March 1, 2018, he only received a copy of the first and last page of the Court's February 23, 2018 order and requests the Court send him another copy of the order.

1       Based on Plaintiff's representation, the Court will direct the Clerk of Court to send Plaintiff  
2 another copy of the Court's February 23, 2018 order and granted Plaintiff thirty additional days to  
3 either file an amended complaint or notify the Court of his intent to proceed only the claims found to  
4 be cognizable.

5       Based on the foregoing, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

6       1.       The Clerk of Court shall send Plaintiff a copy of the Court's February 23, 2018 order  
7 (ECF No. 20);

8       2.       Plaintiff has thirty (30) days from the date of service of this order to either file an  
9 amended complaint or notify the Court of intent to proceed only on claims found to be cognizable; and

10       3.       Failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that the action be  
11 dismissed for failure to comply with a court order.
