On November 15, 2017, the summons and scheduling order issued. (ECF Nos. 2, 3.) 13 Pursuant to the scheduling order, unless other provision is made pursuant to an application to 14 proceed in forma pauperis, appellant is required to effect service within twenty days of filing the 15 complaint and file a return of service with this court. More than twenty days have passed and 16 Plaintiff has not filed a return of service with the Court, nor does the record reflect that service 17 was referred to the United States Marshall. 18 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file a notice within five (5) 19 days informing the Court of the status of service on Defendant in this action.
