**ORDER FOR CLERK TO CLOSE CASE**

22 Christopher Lipsey, Jr. (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma*  
23 *pauperis* with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a  
24 United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

25 On November 5, 2019, [findings and recommendations](#) were entered, recommending that  
26 this case be dismissed based on Plaintiff’s failure to state a claim upon which relief may be  
27 granted under §1983. (ECF No. 33.) On November 18, 2019, Plaintiff filed [objections](#) to the  
28 findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 34.)

1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this  
2 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file,  
3 including Plaintiff's objections, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported  
4 by the record and proper analysis.

5 Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 6 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on November  
7 5, 2019, are adopted in full;
- 8 2. This action is dismissed, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state a  
9 claim upon which relief may be granted under § 1983; and
- 10 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case.
