AMENDED ORDER AFTER IN CAMERA REVIEW OF RECORDS OF VISTA WEST HIGH SCHOOL

At the informal conference re: discovery dispute (Doc. 23), the parties agreed the Court would conduct an in camera review of educational and employment records of the plaintiff. The Court has received and reviewed the records from Vista West High School¹, which included records from Stockdale High School, and Tevis Junior High School. Of these records, the Court finds very few are discoverable because they contain no information which may bear on the issues in this case or because discovery of these records is not proportional to the needs of the case (Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(b)(1).
