ORDER REQUIRING CITY PSYCHOLOGY
TO NOTICE AND SERVE MOTION TO
QUASH ON DEFENDANT UNITED
STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND
SECURITY

FIVE DAY DEADLINE

13 On April 19, 2017, City Psychology, Inc. filed a motion to quash a subpoena issued by
14 the United States Department of Homeland Security. Upon review of the motion, the Court finds
15 that it is deficient. While Plaintiff included in the docket text the date for a hearing set before
16 retired Magistrate Judge Sandra Snyder, there is no notice of motion setting the hearing and the
17 motion needs to be set before the undersigned. Further, there is no proof of service on the United
18 States Department of Homeland Security. Plaintiff shall be required to set a noticed hearing on
19 the motion to quash before the undersigned and serve the motion and notice on Defendant.

20 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Psychology shall notice the motion to
21 quash, serve the United States Department of Homeland Security with copies of the notice and
22 motion, and file a proof of service within five days from the entry of this order.
