ORDER DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE  
COURT TO ADMINISTRATIVELY  
TERMINATE PLAINTIFF’S REQUEST FOR  
A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

(ECF Nos. 6, 17, 18)

Plaintiff Michael J. Velasquez, a civil detainee, is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On January 29, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion for a temporary restraining order to prevent the Department of State Hospitals from implementing amendments to section 4350 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations. On May 9, 2018, findings and recommendations were filed recommending denying Plaintiff’s motion for a temporary restraining order. On May 11, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion to dismiss his motion for a temporary restraining order. Plaintiff states that his request is now moot as his property was confiscated and has been either lost, destroyed, or sent to a third party.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The findings and recommendations filed May 9, 2018, is VACATED (ECF No. 17);

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1           2.       The Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to administratively terminate Plaintiff's motion  
2                   for a temporary restraining order (ECF No. 6).
