Velasquez, a civil detainee, is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in 17 this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On January 29, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion 18 for a temporary restraining order to prevent the Department of State Hospitals from implementing 19 amendments to section 4350 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations. On May 9, 2018, 20 findings and recommendations were filed recommending denying Plaintiff's motion for a temporary 21 restraining order. On May 11, 2018, Plaintiff filed a motion to dismiss his motion for a temporary 22 restraining order. Plaintiff states that his request is now moot as his property was confiscated and 23 has been either lost, destroyed, or sent to a third party. 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 25 1. The findings and recommendations filed May 9, 2018, is VACATED (ECF No. 17); 26 and 27 /// 28
