**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK’S OFFICE
TO SEND PLAINTIFF REGULAR CIVIL
IFP APPLICATION AND REQUIRING
PLAINTIFF TO FILE REGULAR CIVIL IFP
APPLICATION OR PAY FILING FEE IN
FULL WITHIN THIRTY DAYS**

Plaintiff is a former county inmate who has filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. While plaintiff filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis by a prisoner, it appears he was released before his application could be ruled on, and now needs to complete a regular application. Additionally, the Court previously ordered Plaintiff to submit his trust statement. (ECF No. 7.) In light of his current status, Plaintiff is no longer required to file his trust statement.

Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Clerk’s Office shall send Plaintiff a regular civil in forma pauperis application;
2. Within **thirty (30) days** from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall either file a completed regular civil in forma pauperis application or pay the

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\$400.00 filing fee in full.

Failure to obey this order will result in dismissal of this action.
