

1 motion or on its own after notice to the plaintiff--must dismiss the action without
2 prejudice against that defendant or order that service be made within a specified
3 time. But if the plaintiff shows good cause for the failure, the court must extend the
4 time for service for an appropriate period. This subdivision (m) does not apply to
5 service in a foreign country under Rule 4(f), 4(h)(2), or 4(j)(1).

6 Nevertheless, Plaintiff has not filed a proof of service of the summons and complaint as to any
7 defendant. Therefore, the Court **ORDERS**,

8 1. **No later than April 12, 2018**, the plaintiff **SHALL** show cause why sanctions
9 should not be imposed for the failure to serve and file proofs of service on the defendants.
10 Alternatively, the plaintiff may file proofs of service;

11 2. Due the failure of the plaintiff to serve the summons and complaint, the scheduling
12 conference, currently set on April 17, 2018 is **CONTINUED** to **May 25, 2018** at 8:30 a.m.

13 **The plaintiffs are reminded of the service obligations under Fed. R. Civ. P. 4.**
14 **Failure to comply may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of**
15 **unserved defendants.**
