(ECF No. 125.) 14 On September 13, 2022, Defendants filed objections to the pretrial order. (ECF No. 128.) 15 Defendants seek to clarify that they do not intend to call correctional officer Adrien 16 Smith-Walker at trial because the witness is not available. Defendants also seek to clarify that 17 they are not required to file the proposed exhibits with the Court.
