(ECF No. 33.) Accordingly, on September 3, 2020, the 21 Court directed Defendant to file an answer or other responsive pleading to Plaintiff's first 22 amended complaint. (ECF No. 34.) Following the filing of Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration of the Court's order granting in part and denying in part Defendant's motion to dismiss, the Court 23 24 vacated the deadline to file a responsive pleading until after resolution of the motion for reconsideration. (ECF Nos. 35, 37.) 25 26 On January 20, 2021, the District Judge denied Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration. 27 (ECF No. 42.) This action proceeds against Defendant United States of America only on 28 Plaintiff's claim for failure to patrol. (Id.)

1	Accordingly, Defendant shall file an answer or other responsive pleading to Plaintiff's	
2	first amended complaint within twenty-one (21) days from the date of service of this order.
