22 23	conviction and sentencing to the district in which the petitioner was convicted and sentenced.	
23	Such transfers generally further judicial economy since the witnesses and documentation are	
25	present in the district of conviction and sentencing.	
26	In this case, Petitioner was convicted in the Los Angeles County Superior Court and is
