

1 for an extension of time. While not entirely clear, it appears that Plaintiff may be attempting to allege
2 new and unrelated claims in her amended complaint. Plaintiff is advised that, as stated in the Court's
3 July 19, 2018 screening order, Plaintiff may not change the nature of this suit by adding new, unrelated
4 claims in her amended complaint. *George v. Smith*, 507 F.3d 605, 607 (7th Cir. 2007) (no "buckshot"
5 complaints).

6 Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time to file an amended complaint, (Doc. 11)
7 is GRANTED IN PART. Plaintiff shall file her first amended complaint within **thirty (30) days** from
8 the date of service of this order. If Plaintiff fails to file a first amended complaint in compliance with
9 this order, this action may be dismissed for failure to obey a court order and failure to state a claim.
