(Doc. 1 ("Compl.").) Plaintiff alleges that she requires the use of a wheelchair for 23 mobility (Compl. ¶¶ 4, 9), and the property that is the subject of this suit, Best Western Fresno Inn 24 (the "Property"), presents a barrier that interfered with her ability to use and enjoy the goods, 25 services, privileges, and accommodations offered at the Property (Compl. ¶¶ 4, 11–16). Defendant 26 Shyam LLC was served with the Complaint on March 27, 2018 (Doc. 4), and default was entered 27 against it on April 20, 2018. (Doc. 6.)

1	On June 25, 2018, the Court ordered Plaintiff, within 21 days of entry of the order, to file its
2	motion for default judgment against Defendant. (Doc. 7.) In accordance with the order, Plaintiff's
3	motion for default judgment was due to be filed on or before July 16, 2018. (See id.) To date, no
4	motion for default judgment has been filed. Plaintiff is, therefore, ordered to show cause, if any,
5	why the action should not be dismissed for failure to comply with the Court's June 25, 2018, order
6	and for want of prosecution. Alternatively, Plaintiff may file a motion for default judgment against
7	Defendant or a notice of dismissal.
8	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:
9	1. By no later than July 27, 2018 , Plaintiff shall:
10	a. file a written response showing cause why the Court should not dismiss this
11	action for failure to comply with the Court's June 25, 2018, order and for
12	want of prosecution; or
13	b. file a motion for default judgment pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(b)(2) against
14	Defendant; or
15	c. file a notice of dismissal pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i).
16	Failure to respond to this Order to Show Cause will result in a recommendation to the
17	presiding district court judge that this action be dismissed in its entirety.
18	IT IS SO ODDEDED
