No. 118.) The parties are advised that pursuant to the Local Rules of 20 the United States District Court, Eastern District of California, any documents subject to this 21 protective order to be filed under seal must be accompanied by a written request which complies 22 with Local Rule 141 prior to sealing. The party making a request to file documents under seal shall be required to show good cause for documents attached to a non-dispositive motion or 23 compelling reasons for documents attached to a dispositive motion. Pintos v. Pacific Creditors 24 Ass'n, 605 F.3d 665, 677-78 (9th Cir. 2009). Within five (5) days of any approved document 25 filed under seal, the party shall file a redacted copy of the sealed document. The redactions shall 26 be narrowly tailored to protect only the information that is confidential or was deemed 27 confidential. 28
