

2	Complaint for violations of the California Labor Code and Unfair Competition Law	
3	against Indian River Transport Co. ("Defendant").

8	WHEREAS Defendant does not oppose Plaintiff filing a First Amended	
9	Complaint limited to adding the above proposed putative Class Representatives.	
10	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between Plaintiffs and Defendant, by	
11	and through their respective counsel, that:

13	1. Defendant does not oppose the Court's granting Plaintiff leave to file his	
14	First Amended Complaint, which is limited to adding two proposed putative Class	
15	Representatives, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."	
16	2. Defendant's responsive pleading shall be due thirty (30) days after the	
17	First Amended Complaint is filed.

20	The Court having reviewed the foregoing Stipulation, and good cause

23	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff Charles Cooley is granted leave to

28	thirty (30) days after the First Amended Complaint is filed.
