**ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS
(ECF No. 17.)**

**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTIVE RELIEF
(ECF No. 16.)**

19 Luis Renteria (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in
20 this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States
21 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

22 On June 27, 2018, [findings and recommendations](#) were entered, recommending that
23 plaintiff’s motion for preliminary injunctive relief, filed on June 8, 2018, be denied. (ECF No.
24 17.) Plaintiff was granted fourteen days in which to file objections to the findings and
25 recommendations. (*Id.*) On August 2, 2018, the court re-served the findings and
26 recommendations upon Plaintiff at his new address, which allowed Plaintiff fourteen more days
27 in which to file objections. (ECF No. 20.) The time for filing objections has now expired, and
28 Plaintiff has not filed objections or responded otherwise to the findings and recommendations.

1 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this
2 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the
3 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

4 Accordingly, **THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS** that:

- 5 1. The findings and recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on June 27,
6 2018, are ADOPTED IN FULL; and
- 7 2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunctive relief, filed on June 8, 2018, is
8 DENIED.
