Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in this civil rights action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff moves to have his complaint served, complaining that it has been months since he filed his case. See ECF No. 17. My findings and recommendations on screening plaintiff’s complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A are pending before a district judge. See ECF No. 19. Only after screening has been completed will service be considered. Even then, the complaint will not be served if it is dismissed. Therefore, plaintiff’s motion is denied it without prejudice to refileing. ECF No. 17.
