(Doc. 5.) Pursuant 10 to the Court's minute order issued August 8, 2018 (Doc. 4), the Motion for Preliminary Approval 11 of Class Action Settlement was due September 5, 2018, the same day on which the parties filed 12 the above stipulation for an extension. 13 Requests for extension are governed by Rule 144 of the Local Rules of the United States 14 District Court, Eastern District of California ("Local Rules"). Local Rule 144(d) explains that 15 "[r]equests for Court-approved extensions brought on the required filing date for the pleading or 16 other document are looked upon with disfavor." The parties are hereby admonished that any 17 future requests for extensions of time shall be brought in advance of the required filing date and 18 be supported by good cause under Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b)(4). However, given the parties' 19 representations that they have exchanged multiple drafts of the settlement papers and only require 20 an additional fourteen (14) days to finalize the settlement papers (see Doc. 5 at 2), the Court 21 GRANTS the parties' request for an extension. 22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parties have until September 19, 2018, to file the 23 Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement. 24 25 IT IS SO ORDERED. 26 1st Sheila K.
