1 Pursuant to the parties' stipulation, and good cause appearing based upon the medical
2 conditions of Deerpoint Group, Inc.'s employees, the Court GRANTS the parties' request to
3 modify the scheduling order in this case. (Doc. No. 110.) Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
4 ORDERED that the Amended Scheduling Order (Doc. No. 109) is modified as follows:

7 Parties File Joint Claim Construction Statement:	December 8, 2020
8 Claim Construction Discovery Deadline:	January 12, 2021
9 Parties File Opening Claim Construction Briefs:	January 26, 2021
10 Parties File Responsive Claim Construction Briefs:	February 9, 2021
11 Parties File Reply Claim Construction Briefs:	February 16, 2021
12 Claim Construction Hearing:	March 8, 2021 Time: 1:30 p.m. Dept: 2 (AWI)
13 Non-Expert Discovery Deadline:	March 16, 2021
14 Expert Disclosure:	April 27, 2021
15 Supplemental Expert Disclosure:	May 23, 2021
16 Expert Discovery Deadline:	June 22, 2021
17 Dispositive Motion Filing Deadline:	July 20, 2021

18 All other deadlines set forth in the Amended Scheduling Order remain unchanged.

19 The Court notes that the parties filed their stipulation on August 25, 2020, two weeks after
20 the deadline for the parties to exchange claim constructions had lapsed on August 11, 2020. (See
21 Doc. Nos. 109, 110.) The parties are cautioned that future requests for extensions brought after
22 the applicable deadline has expired will be denied as untimely. See L.R. 144(d).

23 The parties are also advised that no further extensions or modifications of the deadlines in
24 this case will be granted absent a demonstrated showing of good cause. Good cause may consist

1 of the inability to comply with court orders in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. Any such future
2 difficulties should be explained.
