Plaintiff's counsel has filed a response, apologizing for the failure to 19 appear and explaining that Plaintiff's counsel inadvertently failed to correctly calendar the 20 May 23, 2019, hearing, and was unavailable at the time set for the hearing. (ECF No. 20.) 21 Plaintiff's counsel further states that she will make every effort to ensure that this does not 22 happen again in the future. (Id.) In light of this explanation, the Court will discharge the order 23 to show cause and reset the matter for hearing. 24 IT IS ORDERED that the order to show cause (ECF No. 19) is DISCHARGED. Oral
