18	Plaintiff Richard Scott Kindred is a civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis	
19	in this civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This matter was referred to a United	
20	States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
21	On March 16, 2022, plaintiff filed a motion requesting injunctive relief. (Doc. No. 100.)	
22	Defendant did not file a response to plaintiff's motion. On May 5, 2022, the assigned magistrate	
23	judge issued findings and recommendations, recommending that plaintiff's motion be denied.	
24	(Doc. No. 102.) Those findings and recommendations were served on the parties and contained	
25	notice that any objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days from the date of	
26	service. (Id. at 4.) To date, no objections have been filed with the court, and the time in which to	
27	do so has since passed.
