Jerry Dillingham ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma* pauperis with this civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

In the motion, Plaintiff references, among other documents, attached exhibits and an attached second amended complaint. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff's motion for leave to amend is denied, without prejudice to Plaintiff refiling the motion with a signed copy of the proposed second amended complaint attached.¹
