ORDER AND FAILURE TO STATE A 15 **CLAIM** Defendant. 16 (ECF No. 7) 17 TWENTY-ONE (21) DAY DEADLINE 18 19 Plaintiff Anthony Scott Berringer, a state prisoner, is appearing pro se and in forma 20 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. 21 On June 11, 2018, the Court found that Plaintiff's complaint failed to state a cognizable 22 claim for relief, and granted plaintiff thirty days to file an amended complaint addressing the 23 deficiencies identified by the Court. (ECF No. 7.) More than thirty days have passed, and 24 Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the order. 25 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days from the date 26 of service of this order, Plaintiff shall show cause in writing why the action should not be 27

dismissed. Plaintiff is warned that the failure to comply with this order will result in a

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recommendation to a district judge that the action be dismissed for failure to comply with a court order and failure to state a cognizable claim for relief. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: **July 23, 2018** UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE
