Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in this civil rights action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The court has referred this matter to a magistrate judge under 28
U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On August 2, 2019, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations that plaintiff proceed on his medical deliberate indifference claims against defendants Depovic and Grewall, and that all other claims and defendants be dismissed. ECF No. 13. Plaintiff filed objections, and then withdrew them. ECF No. 17.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The findings and recommendations issued by the magistrate judge on August 2, ECF No. 13, are adopted in full;
2. Plaintiff may proceed only on his medical deliberate indifference claims against defendants Depovic and Grewall; and
3. All other claims and defendants are dismissed.
