ECF No. 22 DR. DEPOVIC, et al., Defendants. Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in this civil rights action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff moves to have certain claims served in this case that were dismissed at screening. See ECF No. 22. Plaintiff's motion recites some of the procedural history of the case and states that he "now request[s that] the court issue him the service forms immediately." ECF No. 22. In prisoner cases like this one, service is only appropriate for claims that have survived screening. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. Plaintiff provides no basis for service of claims that have been dismissed, and the court finds none. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 7(b)(1)(B). Plaintiff's motion requesting service, ECF No. 22, is denied.
