ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF’S MOTION
REQUESTING SERVICE
ECF No. 22

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding without counsel in this civil rights action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff moves to have certain claims served in this case that were dismissed at screening. *See* ECF No. 22. Plaintiff’s motion recites some of the procedural history of the case and states that he “now request[s that] the court issue him the service forms immediately.” ECF No. 22. In prisoner cases like this one, service is only appropriate for claims that have survived screening. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. Plaintiff provides no basis for service of claims that have been dismissed, and the court finds none. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 7(b)(1)(B). Plaintiff’s motion requesting service, ECF No. 22, is denied.
