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On that same date, counsel for Defendants Ceja and Harris filed a Stipulation for Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice. The stipulation is signed and dated by Plaintiff Alvaro Quezada and Shiran Zohar, counsel for Defendants Ceja and Harris, and indicates that each party shall bear its own litigation costs and attorney's fees. (Doc. 70.)

Accordingly, this action is terminated by operation of law without further order from the Court. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). The Clerk of the Court is directed to terminate all pending motions and deadlines and to close this case.
