The matter was referred to a United States 19 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On June 7, 2019, the Magistrate Judge filed Findings and Recommendations to deny 21 Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief for lack of jurisdiction. (Doc. 39.) This was served on the 22 parties and contained notice that objections were to be filed within twenty-one days. Neither side 23 filed any objections. Local Rule 304(b), (d). 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a 25 de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the 26 Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 27 /// 28
