The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 18 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On February 22, 2019, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendation recommending that Plaintiff's motion for leave to supplement the complaint be denied. The Findings 21 22 and Recommendation was served on the parties and contained notice that objections were to be filed 23 within fourteen days. Plaintiff did not file objections and the time to do so has expired. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a de 25 novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 26 27 ///
