ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS IN FULL (ECF No. 10.)

ORDER DISMISSING THIS CASE, WITH PREJUDICE, FOR FAILURE TO STATE A CLAIM

ORDER FOR CLERK TO CLOSE CASE

Lachoy Roychelle Davis ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma* pauperis with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On November 22, 2019, <u>findings and recommendations</u> were entered, recommending that this case be dismissed based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted under §1983. (ECF No. 10.) Plaintiff was granted fourteen days in which to file objections to the findings and recommendations. (Id.) The fourteen-day time period for filing objections has passed, and Plaintiff has not filed objections or otherwise responded to the findings and recommendations.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

## Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

- The Findings and Recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on November
   22, 2019, are adopted in full;
- 2. This action is dismissed, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted under § 1983; and
- 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to close this case.
