17	Plaintiff, Normal Hall, a state prisoner	proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this	
18	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on January 29, 2019. On August 2, 2019, the		
19	Court issued a First Screening Order dismissing the complaint for violating Rules 18 and 20 of		
20	the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Plaintiff was granted leave to file an amended complaint or		
21	a notice of voluntary dismissal. Although the time has passed for compliance, Plaintiff has not		
22	filed a complaint or notice, or responded in any other manner. Plaintiff was advised that the		
23	action would be dismissed if he failed to comply.		
24	Based on the foregoing, the Court HEREBY RECOMMENDS that this action be		
25	dismissed for violating Rules 18 and 20 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.		
26	These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District		
27	Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within
