22	failure to prosecute. (Doc. No. 70.) Those p	ending findings and recommendations were served
23	on the parties and contained notice that any c	bjections thereto were to be filed within fourteen
24	(14) days after service. (Id. at 5.) To date, n	o objections have been filed and the time in which to
25	do so has now passed.	
26	In accordance with the provisions of 2	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a
27	de novo review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings	
28	and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.
