



1 The parties were provided an opportunity to file objections to the findings and  
2 recommendations. The deadline to file objections has passed and no objections have been filed.

3 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this  
4 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the  
5 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

6 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 7 1. The findings and recommendations issued on March 2, 2023, (ECF No. 92), are  
8 adopted in full; and
- 9 2. Defendant John Doe is dismissed from this action, without prejudice, because of  
10 Plaintiff's failure to provide the Court and the Marshal with accurate and sufficient  
11 information to effect service of the summons and complaint on defendant John  
12 Doe within the time period prescribed by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m).<sup>1</sup>
