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17	Plaintiff Kenneth Davis initiated this action as a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in	
18	forma pauperis by filing a civil rights complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. (Doc. No. 1.)	
19	The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B)	
20	and Local Rule 302.	
21	On May 12, 2021, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations granting	
22	defendant's motion to dismiss due to plaintiff's failure to keep the court apprised of his current	
23	address, ultimately recommending dismissal for failure to prosecute. (Doc. No. 29 at 1–5.) The	
24	findings and recommendations served on plaintiff contained notice that objections were due	
25	within fourteen days. (Id. at 5.) Plaintiff did not file any objections. (See docket). Instead, the	
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1	May 12, 2021 order was returned to the court as undeliverable due to plaintiff not keeping the	
2	court apprised of his address. ( <i>Id</i> .) <sup>1</sup>	
3	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the court has conducted a	
4	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the finding	
5	and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.	
6	ACCORDINGLY, it is ORDERED:	
7	1. The findings and recommendations, filed on May 12, 2021, (Doc. No. 29), are adopted	
8	in full;	
9	2. The Clerk of Court shall assign a district judge to this matter for the purposes of	
10	closure, terminate any pending motions, close this case, and enter judgment against plaintiff.
