18	pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to	0 42 U.S.C. § 1983. ¹ The matter was referred to
19	a United States magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
20	On September 9, 2019, Plaintiff's complaint was screened and he was granted leave to	
21	file an amended complaint. (ECF No. 4.) Plaintiff filed an amended complaint on September	
22	26, 2019. (ECF No. 5.) On October 1, 2019, findings and recommendations issued on October	
23	1, 2019 recommending that the amended complaint be dismissed without leave to amend. (ECF	
24	No. 6.) The findings and recommendations was served on Plaintiff's address of record and he	
25	was notified that any objections to the findings	s and recommendations were to be filed within
26	thirty days from the date of service.

1	On October 7, 2019, Plaintiff filed a notice of change of address and the findings and		
2	recommendations was reserved at his new address. More than thirty days have passed since		
3	Plaintiff was served with the findings and recommendations at his current address and Plaintiff		
4	has not filed objections or otherwise responded.		
5	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a		
6	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the		
7	findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.		
8	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
9	1. The findings and recommendations, filed October 1, 2019, is ADOPTED IN		
10	FULL;		
11	2. Plaintiff's amended complaint is DISMISSED WITHOUT LEAVE TO AMEND		
12	for failure to state a claim; and		
13	3. The Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to close this matter.
