ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS AND
DIRECTING SERVICE

Plaintiff Angelie Patterson proceeds in this Social Security appeal represented by counsel. Plaintiff moves to proceed *in forma pauperis* under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. ECF No. 2. Plaintiff has submitted a declaration regarding her financial circumstances. *Id.* I find that plaintiff’s declaration satisfies the requirements under § 1915 and grant plaintiff’s motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. I also direct a United States Marshal to serve defendant Commissioner of Social Security. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(3).

Order

- a. Plaintiff’s motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted.
- b. The court orders service of process on defendant:
 - i. The clerk must issue summons.
 - ii. The United States Marshals Service must serve a copy of the complaint, summons, and this order on defendant.
 - iii. Plaintiff must assist the marshal upon request.

1 iv. The United States will advance all costs of service.
