

1 recommending that this action be dismissed, without prejudice, for Plaintiff's failure to pay the
2 filing fee pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1914 or to file an application to proceed in forma pauperis
3 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (ECF No. 6). Plaintiff was provided thirty days to file objections,
4 or, alternatively, to file an IFP application or pay the filing fee.

5 On December 10, 2021, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting an extension of time to pay the
6 filing fee or file an IFP application until January 2022, generally stating that his response has
7 been delayed by COVID protocols at his prison. (ECF No. 7).

8 Finding good cause to grant an extension, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 9 1. Plaintiff's motion for extension of time (ECF No. 7) is granted;
- 10 2. No later than January 13, 2022, Plaintiff shall file an IFP application or pay the filing fee
11 within thirty (30) days.
- 12 3. And Plaintiff's deadline to file objections to the November 3, 2021 findings and
13 recommendations (ECF No. 6) is likewise extended to January 13, 2022.
