17	On March 29, 2020, the Court screened Plaintiff's complaint (Doc. 1) and found that it	
18	states a cognizable claim against D. Tiernan but not E. Govea. (Doc. 6.) The Court therefore	
19	directed Plaintiff to file a first amended complaint curing the deficiencies identified in its order or	
20	notify the Court that he wishes to proceed only on the claim found cognizable. (Id. at 5.)	
21	In response to the Court's screening order, Plaintiff filed a notice "requesting to	
22	proceed on the cognizable claim against D. Tiernan, and to remove E. Govea." (Doc. 7.)	
23	Accordingly, and for the reasons set forth in the Court's screening order (Doc. 6), the Court	
24	RECOMMENDS that Defendant Govea be DISMISSED. The Court DIRECTS the Clerk of the	
25	Court to assign a District Judge to this action.	
26	These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District	
27	Judge assigned to this case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within 14 days of	
28	the date of service of these Findings and Reco	ommendations, Plaintiff may file written objections

1	with the Court. The document should be captioned, "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings	
2	and Recommendations." Failure to file objections within the specified time may result in waiver	
3	of rights on appeal. Wilkerson v. Wheeler, 772 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014) (citing Baxter v.	
4	Sullivan, 923 F.2d 1391, 1394 (9th Cir. 1991)).
