**ORDER DENYING MOTION AS MOOT**  
(Doc. 41)

On July 13, 2020, District Judge Dale A. Drozd adopted the undersigned’s findings and recommendations (Doc. 37) and dismissed this action for failure to exhaust administrative remedies. (Doc. 39.)
