(ECF No. 11.) The Court accordingly entered an order on April 15, 2020, 20 directing the Clerk of Court to close the case. (ECF No. 12.) On November 16, 2020, Plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal of this action with 21 prejudice. (ECF No. 13.) However, this case has ended by virtue of Plaintiff's April 14, 2020 22 notice of voluntary dismissal and the Clerk of Court has closed the case. See Commercial Space 23 Mgmt. Co. v. Boeing Co., 193 F.3d 1074, 1077 n.4 (9th Cir. 1999) ("The voluntary filing of the 24 [Rule 41] notice therefore marks the end of the case, and an attempt to deny relief on the merits 25

and dismiss with prejudice is void; the court has no power or discretion to deny plaintiffs' right to

dismiss or to attach any condition or burden to that right.") (citation and internal quotation marks

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omitted).

1	Accordingly, Plaintiff's notice of voluntary dismissal filed on November 16, 2020 (ECF		
2	No. 13) is HEREBY DISREGARDED.
