The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B). On September 20, 2021, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations, recommending that this case be dismissed, without prejudice, for Plaintiff's failure to comply with the court's screening order issued on July 28, 2021. (Doc. No. 11.) The		

1	pending findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any		
2	objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days from the date of service. ( <i>Id.</i> ) To		
3	date, no objections to the findings and recommendations have been filed with the court, and the		
4	time in which to do so has now passed.		
5	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(C), this court has conducted		
6	a <i>de novo</i> review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the
