**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS’
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**
(Doc. 27)

On March 26, 2021, the Court stayed this matter for 90 days and referred it to Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR). (Doc. 25.) The Court ordered the parties, within 40 days, to file a notice indicating whether they agree to proceed to an early settlement conference. (*Id.* at 2.) The Court also ordered defense counsel, within 45 days, to contact the undersigned’s courtroom deputy to schedule the settlement conference. (*Id.*)

Defendants request an extension of time to comply with these orders. (Doc. 27.) Upon review of Defendants’ motion, including defense counsel’s supporting declaration, the Court finds good cause to grant the request. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Defendants’ motion for an extension of time. Defendants shall have until May 26, 2021, to file the Court-provided notice indicating whether they agree to participate in an early settlement conference. Defendants shall have until May 31, 2021, to contact the undersigned’s courtroom deputy to schedule the settlement conference.

¹ The Court declines Defendants’ request to extend the stay of this matter at this time. The Court will consider extending the stay if the parties agree to participate in an early settlement conference that is scheduled for a date after June 24, 2021—the date on which the stay is currently scheduled to end.
