(Doc. No. 80) 11 12 13 Plaintiff Joshua Jason Dalke is proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights 14 action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge 15 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Eastern District of California Local Rule 302. 16 On March 12, 2021, the magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations, 17 recommending that Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction, filed on March 8, 2021, be 18 denied. Doc. No. 80. The Findings and Recommendations were served on Plaintiff and contained 19 notice that objections were to be filed within fourteen days. Id. Plaintiff did not file objections 20 and the time to do so has expired. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a 21 de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court concludes that 22 the findings and recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. 23 24 **ORDER** 25 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 26 The findings and recommendations (Doc.
