GARCIA, and 15 NKIRUKA NDU. 16 Defendants. 17 On January 28, 2025, Defendants filed a motion to modify the current Case Management 18 19 and Scheduling Order (Doc. No. 44) to extend the deadline to file dispositive motions which is currently set for February 6, 2025. (Doc. No. 62). This case is set for a settlement conference for 20 February 3, 2025. (Doc. No. 56). Considering the upcoming settlement conference, Defendants 21 seek an extension until March 24, 2025 to file dispositive motions. 22 Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b) provides for extending deadlines for good cause shown, if the request 23 to extend time is made before the original time, or its extension expires; or, on a motion made 24 after the time has expired, if the party failed to act because of excusable neglect. Additionally, 25 Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(b)(4) permits a court to modify a scheduling order for good cause shown and 26 with the judge's consent. The Court finds good cause to further extend the discovery and 27 dispositive motion deadlines. 28

ACCORDINGLY, it is ORDERED: 1. Defendants' Motion to Modify the Case Management and Scheduling Order (Doc. No. 62) is GRANTED, to the extent set forth herein. 2. The deadline to file dispositive motion is extended to March 24, 2025. Dated: <u>January 29, 2025</u> UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE
