JUDGE AND CLOSE CASE 16 17 Plaintiff Quincy Lamon Ivy ("plaintiff"), proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed the complaint initiating this action on May 4, 2020. (Doc. No. 1). The matter was referred to a 18 United States magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 19 On October 22, 2020, Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean entered findings and 20 recommendations, recommending that "[t]his action be dismissed, without prejudice, based on 21 Plaintiff's failure to prosecute this case" and "[t]he Clerk of Court be directed to close this case. 22 (Doc No. 9 at 3). 23 24 Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to file objections to the findings and recommendations. The deadline to file objections has passed, and plaintiff has not filed 25 26 objections or otherwise responded to the findings and recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 27 28 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the

1	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.
2	Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:
3	1. The findings and recommendations issued by Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean
4	on October 22, 2020, (Doc. No. 9) are ADOPTED IN FULL;
5	2. This action is DISMISSED, WITHOUT PREJUDICE, based on plaintiff's failure
6	to prosecute; and
7	3. The Clerk of Court is directed to assign a district judge to this case for the purpose
8	of closing the case and then to close this case.
9	IT IS SO ORDERED.
