

1 findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 77.) In his objections, Plaintiff appears to request the
2 Court to adopt in full the Magistrate Judge's findings and recommendations and explains how the
3 alleged actions in his complaint impact his wellbeing today. (*Id.* at 5.)

4 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a
5 *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the file, including Plaintiff's objections,
6 the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper
7 analysis.

8 Accordingly,

- 9 1. The findings and recommendations issued on April 13, 2023, (ECF No. 75), are
10 ADOPTED in full;
- 11 2. This action will proceed *only* on the Eighth Amendment deliberate indifference to
12 serious medical needs claims pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 against Defendant Marciel,
13 Graywall, Taylor, Gerderal, and Jane Does #1 and #2 (Claim I) in Plaintiff's second
14 amended complaint;
- 15 3. The remaining claims in Plaintiff's second amended complaint are DISMISSED;
- 16 4. Defendants California Healthcare Receivership Corp., Warden P. Phiffer, and
17 Psychologist Rubbish are DISMISSED from this action; and
- 18 5. The matter is referred back to the Magistrate Judge for further proceedings.
